1. INTRODUCTION

The **Gambia Red Cross Society (GRCS)** was established by an Act of Parliament and became an independent National Society on 5th October 1966. GRCS is a humanitarian organization acting as an auxiliary to the public authorities, and its constitution/statutes are based on the Geneva Conventions and the Fundamental Principles of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement (*Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Voluntary Service, Unity and Universality*).

The GRCS is committed to delivering essential services across various sectors, including Migration and Displacement. To achieve this, the GRCS implements several initiatives and projects funded by different international donors, which include the provision of humanitarian assistance and protection services. These services require mobility to support the implementation of operational activities. Among these interventions, the GRCS is implementing the project “Assistance and Social Support to Migrants in The Gambia” with the support of Spanish Red Cross (SpRC) and co-funded by the European Union (EU).

These tender aims to procure vehicles, ensuring compliance with the standards required by the European Union and other donor partners.

1.1 OBJECTIVE OF THE TENDER

Establish the selection of a supplier for the acquisition of 4 vehicles within the framework of the EU Migration 2025-2029 project, being implemented by the GRCS with the support of the SpRC and the financing from the European Union, ***in compliance with EU Project Guidelines, and in accordance with the Practical Guide on Contract Procedures for EU External Actions (PRAG) and applicable European Union procurement regulations.***

1.2 SCOPE OF THE SERVICES

The supplier will be responsible for the preparation, registration, and delivery of the vehicles at the GRCS headquarters.

2. ELEGIBILITY CRITERIA AND AWARD CRITERIA

1. Administrative Criteria:



Legal Register

- The tenderer must be a legally registered entity established in The Gambia.

Required Evidence:

- Copy of Business Registration Certificate or Trade License
- Tax Identification Number (TIN) / VAT Registration
- Official contact details (address, email, phone)

Declaration of Honour

Criterion:

- The bidder must not be in any situation of exclusion (bankruptcy, fraud, corruption, conflict of interest) and must not appear on any EU restrictive or exclusion lists.

Required Evidence:

- Responsible declaration duly signed and stamped (Annexe 2)
- Code of Conduct (Annexe 3)

Administrative Compliance

Criterion:

- The tenderer could be submitted per lots, signed and compliant tender in accordance with the instructions of the tender document, and fulfil all the technical specifications provided therein.

Required Evidence:

- Present the document signed and stamped (Framework contract – Invitation to tender).
- Technical specifications (Annexe 1) with financial proposal.

2. Operational and technical Capacity

Criterion: The tenderer must demonstrate operational capacity to supply and deliver the goods within the required timeline and according to the specified requirements.

Criterion:

- The supplier should be able to show the ability to source materials consistently, and the operational organization needed to fulfil the contract.



Required Evidence:

- Acceptance of terms and payment methods used by the GRCS (payment within 30 calendar days after submission of a valid invoice and delivery of the goods in accordance with the contract requirements through bank transfer).
- 2 Contracts of others similar services in the last 5 years
- BID security of 220.000 dalasis minimum
- Bank account certificate

3. AWARD CRITERIA:

In the first stage, compliance with administrative criteria requirements will be verified. Missing or incomplete documentation may be subject to a request for clarification or rectification; failure to adequately address such requests may result in the rejection of the offer and prevent it from proceeding to the next phase of evaluation.

- Annexe 3 – Code of Conduct

ANNEXE 3: CODE OF CONDUCT

PRINCIPLES GOVERNING THE SELECTION OF USUAL SUPPLIERS OF THE SPANISH RED CROSS

As a general rule, the relationships of the Spanish Red Cross with its usual suppliers shall be channelled through tenders or competitive offerings, according to the criteria and limits to be set forth in the annual budget execution rules as a means to guarantee transparency in procurement and observance of the principles of equality, competition and technical assessment.

In the performance of its activity and whenever possible, the Spanish Red Cross shall give priority to the selection and contracting of suppliers complying or with the intention to comply with the ten principles of the United Nations Global Compact. This requirement shall also apply in the case of subcontracting.

The Global Compact is a voluntary initiative of the companies, labour organisations, NGO's and other civil society actors, so that the policies and practices of the companies introduce a series of corporate civil liability principles aimed at dealing with the challenge of achieving an integral and sustainable global economy in agreement with the United Nations Millennium goals.

The ten principles of the Global Compact that must be complied with by the usual suppliers of the Spanish Red Cross are the following:

The Spanish Red Cross shall reserve the right to cancel at any time the agreement binding it to a supplier in case the activities of the latter do not observe the ethical criteria set forth by the Spanish Red Cross in this section or somehow compromise the respect and prestige due to its name and emblem.

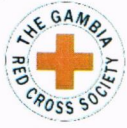

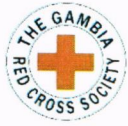
